Son of George Arthur (born 3 Sept 1883) and Eugenie, nee Pointez, (born 2 August 1885) Evans. They married in 1909 their marriage being registered in Nottingham in the December quarter.

On the 1911 Census they are living at 24, Young Street Nottingham. George is a Grocer working for himself and Eugenie was helping with the business.

Their son Frederick Harry was born on 9 June 1917 followed by their second son Harold L. born on 24 October 1922 both births were registered in the Mansfield Registration District.

By the mid 1920s the family had moved to the Gedling area living at 'Gedling House', Gedling Road E.R.1926-1929

By the 1939 register they have moved to Brooklands Drive live in 'Granby' Brooklands Drive.

George A. Evans born 9/06/1883 occupation Railway Goods Guard,

Eugenie Evans born 5/08/1885 occupation Unpaid Domestic Duties (Housewife)

Harold L Evans born 24/10/1922 occupation Accounts Clerk

Frederick H Evans born 9/06/1917 occupation French Polisher.

At some point Frederick joined up and was assigned to the Somerset Light Infantry which in 1944 was part of the Europe invasion force. He died on 31 October 1944 and is buried in the Jonkerbos War Cemetery located in the town of Nijmegen, Netherlands.
