Financial Statement

All Hallows

We raise money to pay for our regular bills and Giving for Ministry through planned giving, collections on the plate, donations, our Annual Birthday Gift appeal, occasional offices, claiming Gift Aid, GASDS and VAT where possible. Fund raising is split equally between PCC funds and the Refurbishment fund.

The Refurbishment fund is used for major projects, topped up with appeals for specific projects, this year it was for our new boilers. In Memoria funds and bequests are directed to our Refurbishment fund. We have a Book of Remembrance with the names of individuals who have helped with our various projects over the years. Decisions over future projects is a collaborative affair, which may come from the Building Committee or from individuals and put to the Finance committee and PCC for approval.

Over the last few years we have experienced a drop in our income from regular givers due to bereavement, moving away, the cost of living and other issues. Like most churches we saw our income drop during Covid as collections couldn't be received on the plate and fund raising and occasional offices was limited. Although we are now building up plate collections and fund raising again, society is changing and there is a move away from having church services for weddings and funerals.

It is with deep regret that we have been unable to meet our commitment to Giving for Ministry for the last few years. The table below shows the changes in our income and in the amount we have paid towards our Deanery Share

We have not been able to meet our Giving for Ministry for a while, to address this, we were preparing to have a Planned Giving Campaign in June 2020. The event was cancelled due to Covid restrictions and at the moment we are on hold due to the cost of living crisis and other issues.
