

ALL HALLOWS FINANCES END MAY

Income for May: Planned Giving £3048 (including planned giving envelopes received), Gift Aid tax recovered £1000. Wall box Donations of £175 and Floodlight donations £70.
Total income for May = £4293

Expenditure for May = £1500 regular bills + £666 gas bill + £3000 for our Giving for Ministry.
Total expenditure for May = £5166

Therefore, overspend by £873 in May and £1392 in April = £2265

Note: Reduction in income as no cash collections in April or May and no income from the Easter and May Bank holiday coffee mornings (Loss £2200).

As you can see with the current lockdown measures our lack of additional source of funding is creating a deficit which will eventually mean that we will be unable to pay our Giving for Ministry in full.

Many thanks for your regular standing orders, your regular giving envelopes and for the additional donations which are being left in the wall safe at the bottom of the church steps.
